Dear Councilmember Yaroslavsky,

My name is [insert]. I live in Cheviot Hills and I'm highly concerned about the Weingart Shelby Shelter that is still scheduled to open in our neighborhood. You promised our community that this shelter would be 55+ only and free from drugs and alcohol use. But based upon contracts that our neighbors unearthed from a public records request, Weingart already signed two contracts with the city where it commits that it will not have any age limits and that it will allow drugs and alcohol use.

At the community Zoom event on December 10, you promised to oppose the project if it allows drugs and alcohol or if it's not 55+.

The safety of my family is at issue here; the integrity of our leadership is at issue here. I sincerely ask you to keep your promise now and oppose the Shelby project!

Besides the fact that the shelter does not meet your own standards, it also faces an ongoing federal criminal investigation. All those responsible for the \$16m overpayment have yet to be identified, including any who may have benefitted. You said at the December 10 meeting that you want to get to the bottom of it and find out what happened. At a minimum shouldn't the project pause while considering that? Why are we rewarding and giving a contract to an entity like Weingart that has proven to be an unreliable partner? I am troubled that this deal was approved by the City to begin with at a price that was over two times its value.

Please stand up for us in the manner you promised: oppose the project!
